# **Application Process**

#### http://astrowin.uwo.ca/

- Application deadline 1 Dec 2016 (earlier better)
- Selection process ends by 15 Dec 2016
- Registration fee \$250. Covers accommodation 5 nights in Hyderabad and lunches, snacks, some transportation in Hyderabad
- Travel costs are responsibility of student
- A Boarding Pass award from Western International can cover almost all airfare cost

# Visa for India

- New e-Tourist visa has streamlined the process. No need to visit consulate or mail them your passport. Total fee ~ US\$90 <u>https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/visa/</u>
- Traditional visa application process also available <u>http://www.blsindia-canada.com/visa.php</u>
- Tourist visa is the best option (not student visa)
- Passport should have at least six months validity from the date of arrival in India
